Galactic Neighbor

The Triangulum Galaxy (Messier 33) is the third largest galaxy in the Local Group of galaxies, after the Andromeda Galaxy and the Milky Way, and is approximately 2.7 million light-years distant.



Space Cloud

Approximately 1350 light-years away, the Orion Nebula's gas has collapsed down to form the Trapezium star cluster in its core. The two nebulae visible are part of the same complex, and only appear separated because of a dark dust lane in front of them.
