Broad Street Scientific Policies on Use of Artificial Intelligence

- 1. While there are some exceptions dealt with case-by-case, the use of images created by Generative AI is not allowed.
- 2. Al-assisted technologies (such as ChatGPT) should not be listed as co-authors.
- 3. In authorship, information about AI use should be disclosed such as the full prompt, what AI tool was used and what version, etc.
- 4. All materials produced using AI should be carefully reviewed by the *author* to ensure there is no plagiarism, misinformation, etc.
- 5. Al technology should not replace the researchers' work such as drawing conclusions from data, but only be used to improve the text's comprehensibility.
- 6. Generative vs. Machine Learning: Al cannot be used for creating material, but can be used for aiding procedures (e.g. manipulating, combining, or enhancing existing images or figures).
