

Broad Street Scientific Policies on Use of Artificial Intelligence

1. While there are some exceptions dealt with case-by-case, the use of images created by Generative AI is not allowed.
2. AI-assisted technologies (such as ChatGPT) should not be listed as co-authors.
3. In authorship, information about AI use should be disclosed such as the full prompt, what AI tool was used and what version, etc.
4. All materials produced using AI should be carefully reviewed by the *author* to ensure there is no plagiarism, misinformation, etc.
5. AI technology should not replace the researchers' work such as drawing conclusions from data, but only be used to improve the text's comprehensibility.
6. Generative vs. Machine Learning: AI cannot be used for creating material, but can be used for aiding procedures (e.g. manipulating, combining, or enhancing existing images or figures).
